Dear Shooting Friends,

On behalf of the European Shooting Confederation, the Estonian Shooting Sport Federation hereby invites you to the European Youth League Championship which will be organized in Tallinn (Estonia). The Estonian Shooting Sport Federation will host the competition at the Kalev Sports Hall with 40 electronic targets from SIUS.

1. Venue – Shooting Range

Kalev Sports Hall, Juhkentali 12, 10132 Tallinn, GPS coordinates 59.4273° N, 24.7605° E



2. Participants and Entries

Youth athletes who will be under the age of 19 on December 31st and over the age of 14 in the year of the competition (Rule 1.1.4) are eligible to participate.

The mixed team (Rule 1.1.5) of each Federation consists of 4 athletes for air rifle and 4 athletes for air pistol, 2 girls and 2 boys (6 entered athletes maximum) (Rule1.3.1.)

The ISSF ID Number is not necessary for participation at the ESC Youth League Championship.

The entry fee is 150 EUR for 4 to 6 athletes.

The draw of each Team (T1...T5) will be done at the Technical Meeting.

4. Competition

The Final consists of two (2) parts:

- •Semi-Finals.
- •Medal Matches

The Semi-Finals consist of: (Rule 6.3)

Two (2) Competition Groups will be composed as follow:

Group 1: ranking 1,3,5,7,9 and Group 2: ranking 2,4,6,8,10 (Rule 6.3.1)

The five (5) teams of a Competition Group will compete team versus team to qualify for the Medal Matches.

Semi-Finals Rule: (Rule 6.4.)

- Thirty (30) shots each team member (three (3) times ten (10) shots)
- No individual ranking
- Team results count only.

Medal Matches consist of: (Rule 6.5.)

After the Semi-Finals, the teams will compete as follow:

- The two teams ranked second of both groups will compete for the Bronze,
- The two winners of both groups will compete for the Gold and the Silver.

Shooting time for the Medal Matches (Gold/Silver and Bronze): (Rule 6.6.)

Reporting time: thirty 30min before the start time

Presentation (the coach will present their athletes)

Five (5) min Preparation and Sighting time

Shot by shot in 50s after each shot the results will be announced.

7. Transportation

Transportation fee from Tallinn Airport to the hotel and from hotel to the Tallinn Airport is 20 EUR per person.

8. Import procedures

Air guns and air pistols with a caliber of 4,5 mm or less may be imported into Estonia without a license by people of age 18 years or more. For participants under 18 years of age, the weapon should be carried by a coach or Team leader.

The Estonian Shooting Sport Federation invites all participants to an "informal" banquet which will take place on October 7, 2023 at 19:00. The cost of the dinner is EUR 20,-/person.
